Our pie and savouries fundraiser was extremely successful. There were 62 fundraisers (out of 194 families) who sold \$10,786 worth of pies and savouries. The top selling class was Room 6. They sold \$2,405 worth of product. They will have a pizza lunch next week. The top seller was Raukura-Jade (R6) who raised a total of \$683. She will receive a \$100 Warehouse voucher.
